- **Questions** – Do you have questions about the position, requirements, or company? Write these questions down, and bring them with you to get answers on the spot.
- **Interview/Meet the Recruiter** – This is a chance to share more about your background and career goals. Recruiters will ask questions about your **previous work experience, why you want to work for the company, and what makes you a good candidate for the position.** Be prepared to answer these questions!
- **And – Dressing Professionally** – won't hurt your chances of landing the job!
