Aspiritech offers specialized learning designed for neurodivergent adults seeking to start or grow a career in cybersecurity.

Our Registered Cybersecurity Pre-Apprenticeship Program for Illinois residents provides hands-on training, industry-aligned curriculum, and real-world experience to help participants gain the confidence and skills that employers value.

LEARNING OUTCOMES

Participants explore core cybersecurity domains such as network and application security, threat detection, cryptography, incident response, and governance. Group study, mock exams, and guidance for résumé development and job readiness are included in the program.

Successful participants earn CompTIA Security+ certification, an industry-recognized credential.

ELIGIBILITY

- Neurodivergent adults motivated to start a cybersecurity career
- Illinois residents only
- High school diploma or equivalent recommended
- Basic IT knowledge & interest
- Some familiarity with computer programming recommended

PLACEMENT & COMPENSATION

- After a 12-week training period, participants receive a six-month apprenticeship placement at Aspiritech or partner organization
- Pay starts at \$20.55 per hour and progresses to \$34.25 per hour
- Apprentices work 30-40 hours per week depending on placement for 2,000 hours total
