REQUIRED DOCUMENT CHECKLIST

Please bring these items to ensure volunteer attorneys can
advance the petition process:

- ✓ Valid Photo ID (State ID or Driver's License)
 - ✓ RAP Sheet / Full Criminal History Copies*
 - ✓ Case Numbers & specific court disposition papers
- *Allow 3 weeks to obtain criminal record, including fingerprint scan

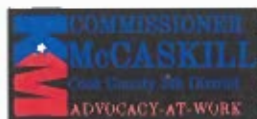
