<p><b>TABE 11&amp;12 Reading</b></p> <p><b>TABE 11&amp;12 Math</b></p>	<p>Yes, if using TABE 11&amp;12 computer-based tests.</p> <p>Paper tests cannot be given remotely.</p> <p>Only 1 to 5 students can be tested at one time.</p>	<p>In order to administer the TABE 11&amp;12 test remotely, a program must be using the TABE computer-based test. Paper tests cannot be given remotely. Anyone who gives a student the TABE 11&amp;12 must be trained in test administration. (Click <a href="#">HERE</a> for more information.)
